Annex 2. The Structure and Format of the Article

Requirements to the materials presented:

Articles can be presented in the Armenian, Russian and English languages in electronic versions. Only the articles that have not been published anywhere previously, are accepted to the conference. Participation certificates will be awarded to the on-site participants.

Computer design:

File- Microsoft Office Word 2007, Paper size- A4

Margins: top - 25 mm, bottom - 25 mm, left - 25 mm, right - 25 mm

Font – For Armenian: GHEA Grapalat, For Russian and English: Times New Roman

Size - 12 pt

Line Spacing - 1

First Line - 1 cm

Do not use more than one space.

Heading (**Bold**) is indicated on the first page of the center, use capital letters.

On the next line **Information about the author(s)** (aligned to the right):

- Author's *last name, first name (Bold, Italics)*
- *Academic title and degree (Italics)*
- *Workplace (institution/organization) (Italics)*
- *Country (Italics)*
- *Author's email address (Italics).*

Writing the phrase “Key words” and putting 7-10 key words or phrases. Key words must not be repeated in the headline of the article. The article should include the following points:

1. **Introduction**
2. **The Goal of the Research**
3. **The Objective of the Article**
4. **The Scientific Novelty of the Research**
5. **The Main Content**
6. **Conclusion**
7. **Recommendations**
8. **References**

Tables, figures and graphics should be numbered, explaining the title (**10 pt, Bold, Italics**). The sizes of graphics material - not more than 110 mm, height - no more than 170 mm, the size of the text in the figures - 10 pt.

Formulas and mathematical expressions are presented by Microsoft Equation, *Italics*, 10 pt, and the main expressions in the center with a separate line. The latter can be numbered on the right corner at the same line in parenthesis: ().

For those articles that contain symbols not in GHEA Grapalat font, it is necessary to provide an electronic font of those symbols.

References to literature are indicated in square brackets in the text - []¹

Notes are given at the bottom of the page with the increasing numbering.

Following the text the word "**References**" (**in Bold**) is written. From the next line - the list of references with increasing numbering.

After the list of references the summary, including key words, is presented separately in both languages². The content of the summary and keywords in both languages must be identical and consist of 150-200 words.

Please specify the article title, the next line - the author's name and surname, then the word "Summary" and the text of abstract, then – the keywords.

The volume of the article should comprise 7-12 pages.

To prevent plagiarism, articles will be published only after undergoing a specialized review.

If the author of the article is a Master's student, a letter of recommendation from the scientific supervisor is required.
